Pursuant to Missouri's Sunshine Law, I am requesting records related to parking enforcement actions taken by the Treasurer calendar year 2025. Specifically, I am requesting records that reflect the following information:

- The total number of vehicles towed by the Streets Department in 2025 due to unpaid parking tickets.
- The total number of vehicles that had a wheel boot applied in 2025 due to unpaid parking tickets.
- The number of vehicles eligible for booting (sometimes referred to as a "boot list") throughout 2025.

For the boot list data, I am seeking a general sense of scale over time rather than a specific format. If available, a snapshot of vehicles on the boot list at regular intervals—such as the first day of each month in 2025—would be sufficient, though similar breakdown that is readily accessible.

If any portion of this request is unclear, or if there is a more efficient way to provide the information, please let me know. fees associated with fulfilling this request, please advise me of the estimated cost before proceeding. Thank you for your assistance.
