**Subject:** Sunshine Law Request: Parking Meter Inventory, Operability, and Revenue

Dear Custodian of Records,

Pursuant to the Missouri Sunshine Law, Chapter 610, RSMo, I respectfully request access to public records maintained by the St. Louis Treasurer's Office relating to the operation and performance of the City's parking meter system.

Specifically, I request **any and all records** sufficient to show the following:

#### 1. Parking Meter Inventory and Status

- The total number of parking meters under the Treasurer's authority.
- Records identifying how many parking meters are:
  - In active service and operational
  - Inoperable or out of service
  - Temporarily disabled, removed, or decommissioned
- Any reports, dashboards, spreadsheets, or databases used to track meter operability, outages, repairs, or downtime.

#### 2. Meter Downtime and Maintenance

- Records reflecting how long parking meters were inoperable, out of service, or otherwise unable to collect payment.
- Maintenance logs, work orders, or service tickets related to parking meter repairs.
- Any internal reports evaluating meter uptime, failure rates, or service performance.

### 3. Parking Meter Revenue

- Records showing gross parking meter revenue collected by the City, including:
  - Total revenue by month and by year
  - Revenue by meter zone or geographic area, if tracked
- Any internal summaries, financial reports, or reconciliations used to monitor parking meter revenue.

### 4. Contractor or Vendor Records

- Records identifying any vendors or contractors responsible for parking meter installation, maintenance, software, payment processing, or data tracking.
- Any reports, correspondence, or performance evaluations related to meter operability or revenue collection involving those vendors.

#### **Timeframe:**

**January 1, 2024 through January 26, 2026.**

If responsive records exist in electronic format, I request that they be provided electronically, in their native format where possible.

If you determine that no responsive records exist for any portion of this request, please confirm that determination in writing.

If any portion of the requested records is withheld or redacted, please provide the non-exempt portions and cite the specific statutory basis for each denial or redaction, as required by § 610.023.3, RSMo.

If fees are anticipated to exceed \$50, please provide a cost estimate in advance. I request that any fees be waived or reduced in the public interest, as these records concern the administration of public infrastructure and the collection of public revenue.

Please respond within the time required by law.
